Through the corresponding department of home University, the following documents must be sent via e-mail:

1. Application for Student Mobility for Foreign Undergraduate Students.
2. Passport Copy.
3. Cover letter.
4. Letter of recommendation from 1 professor.
5. Basic Spanish Certificate (CEB) or equivalent.
6. Certificate stating grades and average and that the student has completed more than 50% of the career.
7. 1 photo with blue or white background, could be digital or scanned.
8. Full academic program from home university.
9. Receipt of registration of the home university. If tuition fees are not paid, certification of being an active student.

- Applications for the academic semester going from August to December 2017, must be sent by the International Relations Office of the Origin University to: relint@utp.edu.co
- We suggest to send the documents in a PDF dossier with the name of the student.



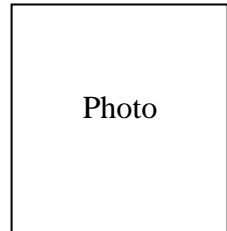
